

## Treatment of infraorbital area and temporal area as areas that are connected in aesthetic and anatomic aspects. Hyaluronic acid injections into the underlying structures. Injection volumes and techniques

Hyaluronic acid in varying chain lengths and cross-linking densities is routinely injected into dermis to volumize dermal matrix and treat signs of aging.

**Materials and Methods:** a specific combination of HA crosslinked by 1,4-butanediol-diglycidylether and HA stabilized in the carboxyl and hydroxyl groups per inner esterification. Subdermal use.

Subdermal injections into SOOF of the combination of HA crosslinked by 1,4-butanediol-diglycidylether and HA stabilized in the carboxyl and hydroxyl groups per inner esterification stimulate dermal cells and extracellular matrix. They can be used for treatment of tear trough and palpebromalar area, especially in case of dry skin with reduced elasticity. This combination does not cause swelling in this area which is naturally prone to it. At the same time, infraorbital area is connected with low temporal area and they should be treated together in one session.
